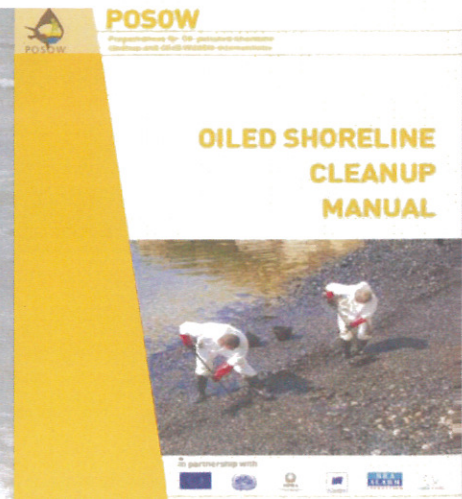

Workshop Background

As a part of MOIG annual technical session, members from various Mediterranean countries have expressed an interest to hold this year a workshop titled "Oiled Shoreline Cleanup Training Course" according to Preparedness for Oil-Polluted Shoreline Cleanup and Oil Wildlife interventions-POSOW project manual procedures. The main objective of the workshop is to improve awareness and preparedness and response to shoreline pollution. The training course will be animated by Mr Arnaud Guéna, Operation Manager and POSOW Project Coordinator from the Centre of Documentation, Research and Experimentation on Accidental Water Pollution (Cedre).

Exercise Scenario

The Skhira Tier 1 Oil Spill Response Exercise is a Simulation of an Oil Spill due to flexible blowout during the loading operations of one oil tanker accosted in the Jetty. The quantity of the spill is estimated between 15 to 20 m³ and would threaten much the shoreline and sensitive areas due to currents and winds, leading to the activation on TRAPSA Oil Spill Contingency Plan.

Development & Resources & Scheduled Operations



- An Exercise Steering Committee composed of TRAPSA, MOIG and Cedre was created to ensure the development, design, management and conduct the Oil Spill Response and Oiled Shoreline Cleanup exercises
- Exercise Steering Committee Members : Hedi Bourouis, Adel Hrzi, Imed Trifa, Moez Krichen, Mokhtar Cherif, Anouar El Borji (TRAPSA), Houcine Mejri (MOIG) and Arnaud Guéna (Cedre)
- Mobilization of 04 response teams : On shore, Offshore, HSE and Shoreline Cleanup
- Notification according to TRAPSA Oil Spill Contingency Plan
- Containment of oil spill using 400 meters of fence booms
- Deployment of fence booms using Khenaiies 1, Khenaiies 2 and Khenaiies 3 boats
- Recovery and storage of crude oil using skimmer Kamora 20 and floating storage and retention basin.
- Assistance through Mereksen & Younga & Douleb tugs.
- Evacuation of an injured person from the response team slipped on the jetty during the recovery of OSR equipments
- Oiled Shoreline Cleanup according to POSOW manual procedures including shoreline survey, worksite organization, manual collection of debris, high pressure cleanup and effluent recovery, decontamination and equipment re-packaging
